

All NCUK programmes also include a specialist English for Academic Purposes module designed to provide students with the language and study skills necessary to give them a head start on an undergraduate degree in the UK, USA, Australia, etc.

NCUK International Foundation Year Pathways and Module Outlines

The NCUK IFY is specifically designed for international students to provide them with the skills necessary to succeed at university.

NCUK Partners with British Council (Thailand)

One Compulsory Module:

English For Academic Purpose (EAP)

The aim of the NCUK EAP module is to provide students with the necessary English language and academic skills required by UK university programmes.


NCUK recognises the importance of a solid foundation in English. Therefore the EAP component accounts for 224 hours while other subjects study for 112 hours of the entire course. This ensures that all our students are sufficiently prepared for their chosen degree in the UK.

At NCUK Thailand, the English for Academic Purpose and study skills (EAP) component is taught by British Council teachers who hold DELTA (Diploma in Teaching English) qualifications.

EAP is recognized by NCUK's partner university for entry without further English language certification

Offers made on an IELTS equivalency basis;

- A = IELTS 7.0
- B = IELTS 6.5
- C = IELTS 6.0



Plus three (3) additional modules directly related to the student's chosen pathway:

Economics

The overall aim of this module is to provide an introduction to the basic economic concepts and principles. Reference is made mainly to the UK experience in preparation for studying with British students at university. The first semester will deal with "micro" economic issues and the second "macro" economic issues.

Micro Economics covers: Economic Systems; Demand, Supply and Market Price; Business Economics.

Macro Economics covers: The main objectives of Government Economic Policy; Economic Growth; Taxation and Government Spending; Money and Monetary Policy; Inflation and Unemployment; Trade Policy.

Mathematics

The overall aim of this module is to equip students with the mathematical knowledge and skills necessary for entry into the first year of any UK/Western undergraduate degree course. The module covers the following areas: Algebra, Binomial Expansions, Trigonometric Functions, Laws of Indices, Exponential Function; Calculus, Statistics, Trigonometric Identities, Probability and Set Theory, Correlation and Linear Regression, Probability Distributions and Further Integration.

Business studies

The overall aim is to ensure that students have a solid grounding in many aspects of business studies and feel confident in commencing the study of business-related courses at undergraduate level. Students will be studying:

- **Marketing:** The Nature of Marketing; Market Analysis; Segmentation and Positioning; Market Research; Marketing Strategy; Marketing Mix.
- **Accounting and Finance, Human Resources:** Organisational Structure and Design; Motivation; Leadership and Management Styles.
- **Business and the Legal Environment, Fundamentals of Management:** Strategy and Objectives. Operations management is not included.

Society and politics

The overall aim of this module is to ensure that students have a solid grounding in many as-

pects concerning the study of society and politics and feel confident in undertaking undergraduate studies in this field. The module is based mainly on sociology, and specifically on the 'A' and 'AS' level sociology specifications approved by the QCA. This module covers the following areas: Social Class, Social Class, Wealth and Poverty, Globalisation, Democracy, Participation and Ideology, the British Government, Society, Politics, and the Environment.

Physics

This module covers the following areas: Mechanics, Electricity, Vibrations and Waves; Thermal Physics; and Nuclear Physics. In order to be taught within the single academic year available, the syllabus has been modified and the following major topics, normally taught at Physics "A" level, are not covered: First and Second Laws of Thermodynamics; optional topics such as Astrophysics, Medical Physics, Particle Physics and Electronics. These topics are adequately introduced in the relevant undergraduate courses at NCUK partner universities if required and assume no prior knowledge.

Chemistry

This module is intended to give students a firm grounding in the many aspects of chemistry and will enable them to feel confident in commencing the study of chemistry and related subjects at undergraduate level. Students will be learning: Atomic Structure and Mass, Chemical Bonding, Metallic Bonding, Hydrogen Bonding and Simple Intermolecular Forces, Molarity and Balanced Equations, Empirical and Molecular Formulae, Oxidation and Reduction, Transition Elements. Alkanes and Alkenes, Alcohols, Aldehydes and Ketones, Energetics and Equilibrium, Kinetics, and Spectroscopy.

Biology

This module is intended to give students a firm grounding in many aspects of biology and will enable them to feel confident in commencing the study of biology and related subjects at undergraduate level. This module covers the following topics: Structure and Function of Biological Molecules, Organs, Tissues, Cellular Organisation and Cell Structure, Plant structure and Photosynthesis, Cell Membrane Structure and Transport, Molecular Genetics: DNA Replication and Protein Synthesis, Cellular reproduction, Physiological systems, Homeostasis, and Interpretation of Scientific Data.

This pathway prepares students in a variety of subject areas and offers a wide range of progression options, particularly suited to those seeking a career in business, finance and all areas of management. This is the best pathway to follow for students interested in studying maths as one of their modules during the International Foundation Year while keeping their options open to business and humanities.

NCUK International Year One

The pathway to year two of an undergraduate degree

The NCUK International Year One (IYOne) is equivalent to the first year of an undergraduate degree. NCUK IYOne gives students access to Year Two of a UK degree. Two main subject areas are offered: **Business and Engineering**.

The programme is taught over 9 months and is assessed via examinations and coursework. As well as equipping students with the English skills and academic qualifications necessary for studying in the UK, the IYOne provides cultural awareness and teaches students how to learn in a Western environment.

The programme offers a number of study options for students with varying levels of English language skills and qualifications. Students can enter the programme with a minimum of IELTS level 5.5 or equivalent. Alternatively, students can take an English language test provided by NCUK prior to enrolment. Students with English as a second language will typically study the English for Academic Purposes module alongside their subject modules since it provides an English language qualification recognised by NCUK universities for visa purposes, rendering an IELTS test unnecessary.

Once students pass the NCUK programme, they are guaranteed entry into an NCUK university. **This guarantee is exclusive to NCUK.** As only the very best partners are allowed to offer NCUK programmes to students, access to outstanding teachers, facilities and learning environments is assured.

Students can apply to up to five universities. Each NCUK university has its own entry criteria for each course, so it is important that students do as well as possible in the NCUK exams to have the best chance of getting into their first choice university.





NCUK provides a high level of support to students throughout the admissions procedure. All students are interviewed online or in person by a senior member of our staff.

Admissions Procedure

1. Complete the application form and return with the following supporting documentation:
 - Copy of passport and previous UK visa(s)
 - Copy of any English language qualifications
 - Copies of previous school qualifications/reports/transcripts
 - 1-inch photo
 - Copy of house registration
 - Copy of ID card
2. Attend an interview with a senior member of staff and sit an entrance test if required.
During the interview, expert and honest advice will be offered on programme/subject selection and how to make a competitive university application. Students may be required to sit an English or maths test depending on their qualifications and the course they are applying for. An interview may take place at a British Council office overseas when NCUK staff are visiting a particular region or via Skype.
3. Receive a decision on the application (usually within 1–2 weeks).
